Medical malpractice insurance policies will limit the amount of liability they will cover in a year. A typical policy will set a cap of \$1 million per occurrence and \$3 million in total liability claims in a year. Therefore, if you have one lawsuit in a year and were ordered to pay \$1.5 million in damages, your policy would cover \$1 million.
